


Cursive Writing:

We will slowly introduce cursive writing to our third grade students this year. Most students have learned parts of this skill in 2nd grade. We will begin by writing our names and the alphabet in cursive. We will practice daily ,but will NOT start completing tests/ classwork in cursive until after

winter break.

Social Studies

We started our first social studies chapter this week with our study of globes, maps, compasses, directions, oceans, and continents. Students will be tested on the seven continents and 4 oceans (although some people consider the "Southern Ocean" to be the 5th ocean.)

Math:
