

This week, we will continue our newest science unit titled, "Earth Science." We will discuss weather and climate, the Earth's atmosphere (5 layers), clouds, wind, weather forecasts, and weather tools. We will learn about predicting the weather,

contribute to the weather in our area of the world. We will also check the weather (pressure, humidity, wind speed/direction) to determine if precipitation is possible—and what type of precipitation. Additionally, we will focus on weather and climate related vocabulary and create our own daily weather logs.
