Cursive Writing:

We will continue to slowly and surely incorporate cursive into our daily activities.

Science

Last week, we started our newest science unit titled, "Earth Science." Our first investigation discussed weather and climate. We learned about predicting

the weather, and what factors contribute to the weather in our area of the world. We also check the weather (pressure, humidity, wind speed/direction) to determine if precipitation was possible—and what type of precipitation. This week, we will focus on weather and climate related vocabulary as well as create our own daily weather logs.

Math:
